



**GRAD scholars complete college at a rate 89 percent higher than the national average for low income students**

A study of the first three classes of GRAD scholars from Davis High School in Houston shows that 46 percent completed college four to eight years after enrollment. In contrast, according to a national study released by the Department of Education, only 27 percent of equivalent low income students that enrolled between 1991 and 1993 completed college four to eight years later. Davis graduates complete college at a 70 percent rate above the national average for low income students.
